The following competency profiles are especially sought after: expertise in the communication and health sectors, accounting, traditional and digital marketing as well as human resources management.


Implication

VOLUNTEER SERVICES OFFERED BY SARPAD




We have come to realize that our elders wish to remain at home as long as possible. For more than 40 years in the Côte-des-Neiges borough and 20 years in Outremont, SARPAD has been meeting your needs by offering volunteer services to seniors with reduced autonomy and to their family caregivers.

Our services cover: transportation and assistance for medical appointments, assistance for errands (groceries, shopping, banking), friendly home visits, weekly calls to create and maintain friendly bonds, neighborhood walks to stay in shape.

Since 2021, in answer to multiple requests, we have added 3 new services to further support our elders: An **Income Tax Clinic** given by volunteers with Revenue Agency training, a **Snow Brigade** in partnership with the Carrefour jeunesse-emploi Côte-des-Neiges and the *Groupe scout 55e Guynemer d'Outremont*, the **Digital Project**, a series of initiation workshops to help our beneficiaries cope with digital technology.

All these services bring a sense of peace of mind and security to our beneficiaries and aim to improve their quality of life.
